## **TCN Business Session - July 7 & 9, 2016 – Grapevine, TX**

President Tom Danklefsen called the annual business session to order.

Board Secretary Denise Craig provided proof of notice by acknowledging that notice of the annual business meeting had been emailed on June 17, 2016, to each voting member of the Association in compliance with Section 3.3 of our Bylaws.

Denise provided a proof of quorum by asking all Active, Associate and Emeritus members to raise their hands. She reminded the members the minutes of the 2015 Annual Business Session, held on July 14 & 16, 2015, were included in the 2015 Annual Conference Report that was published and has been available to all active members on The Church Network website. The minutes were submitted for approval. A motion and a second came from the floor, and the minutes were approved unanimously.

Tom called on Dana Fickling to make a Governance Committee report. Dana explained one of the duties of the governance committee is to solicit recommendations and submit a slate of candidates for the board of director positions no less than fourteen days prior to the first regular business session of the annual conference. The Governance Committee sent the slate of nominees to the membership in the June 17th edition of The Link. The list is also printed in the conference notebook. Dana asked each nominee to stand.

Tom recessed the meeting until Saturday, July 9, 2016

On Saturday, Tom called the meeting back to order.

Tom asked if there were any questions regarding any of the reports in the notebook. There were none. Tom reminded the membership of the 20% challenge he issued at last year's conference. Although we had over 160 first timers at conference, and we are gaining new members, we seem to have an issue with retention. He encouraged everyone to go back and tell the story. He thanked everyone for the opportunity to serve as President for the last two years. He thanked his wife, Pam, the staff and the board. Most of all, he thanked God, through whom all things are possible.

Simeon presented Tom with a plaque for his service.

Tom called for a vote since the recommendation came from the Governance Committee and did not require a second. The slate of officers and directors was elected unanimously.


CEO Simeon May installed the new officers and directors, reading from I Peter 4:7-11. He led the audience in prayer for the board.

## PT&S REPORT

One of the values of The Church Network is to strive to be a life-long learner by seeking to attain the highest degree of competency in your field. By attending the national conference, your local chapter meetings, TeleWebs, and contacts throughout the year with your fellow church leaders, is proof that you are living out this value. I applaud you!

The purpose of the Professional Training and Standards Committee is to fulfill the significant role of the mission of The Church Network, which is to assist individuals serving Christ through administration in local churches, to achieve the highest level of professional competence. The PT&S does so by being the oversight committee for the Certified Church Administrator (CCA) certification program. Each of you is the most important reason the PT&S Committee exists.

Last April, the PT&S Committee met for a 2-day retreat. We focused on certification center changes; The center at Candler in Atlanta has moved to Nashville and is hosted by the General Council on Finance and Administration of the United Methodist (we welcome GCFA), and the center in Springfield MO (Assembly of God Theological Seminary) closes this summer. Our focus is on identifying opportunities to locate and deliver certification center programs in the Mountain and Pacific time zones. We also reviewed the 14 domains of knowledge. The committee is unanimous in agreement that exposure to the 14 are critical to achieve the CCA. Lastly, we continue to focus on enhancing the CCA certification process, and accessibility of learning opportunities. Check out the eLearning Lab online at the TCN web site.

Achieving the CCA designation is more than the opportunity to place three letters after your name on stationary. It is a benefit of The Church Network membership, that results in the personal satisfaction that you are committed to striving for lifelong learning, it is the relationships that you build with other administrative leaders as you work through the program, it is recognition to those outside our field of your competency – it is really a new start – to be better at serving Christ and your church.

To this year's new CCA recipients, I thank God you persevered; you have achieved your goal! Congratulations.
